Candice Lawton



Candice Lawton is a circular economy leader with more than a decade of experience driving sustainability and systems change at the intersection of business, community, and the environment. She is currently the Executive Director of Circular Philadelphia (<https://circularphiladelphia.org/>) which brings together individuals, businesses, manufacturers, institutions, local government, and policy makers to lead the shift to a circular economy in the region. She has held senior leadership roles at pioneering circular economy organizations like TerraCycle and rePurpose Global and led the Community Partnerships team at Philabundance, where she managed a network of more than 350 partners distributing rescued and surplus food across the region. She regularly speaks on industry podcasts and at leading events including Sustainability in Packaging, Sustainable Brands and Trellis. She serves on the board of the Arrupe Center for Business Ethics at St. Joseph's University and is also a board member of Campus Race to Zero Waste, a nationwide initiative that supports waste reduction and circular practices on college campuses.

Chef Edmund “Eddie” Konrad is a Philadelphia-born chef whose fine-dining pedigree shapes the culinary voice of Messina Club in South Philadelphia. Eddie was born and raised in Philadelphia where he attended Mercy Vocational High School and studied culinary arts. He realized at a young age that being in the kitchen made him feel like he was finally a part of something. He trained in rigorous kitchens up and down the East Coast—Learning at institutions like Le Bec-Fin in Philadelphia and Del Posto in New York—before returning home as chef de cuisine at Laurel, and can now be found heading the acclaimed kitchen at Messina Social Club. If you recognize Eddie, you remember him as a fan favorite on Top Chef (Season 16), where his craftsmanship and straight-ahead style stood out. In Philadelphia, he became widely known for elegant, seasonally driven tasting menus and exacting technique. He has always strived to improve his own skills as well as provide an educational environment for his fellow chefs and employees. As a father, Eddie is a natural teacher and mentor to those who work around him. His focus on creating experiences for his guests is always at the core of his culinary work.

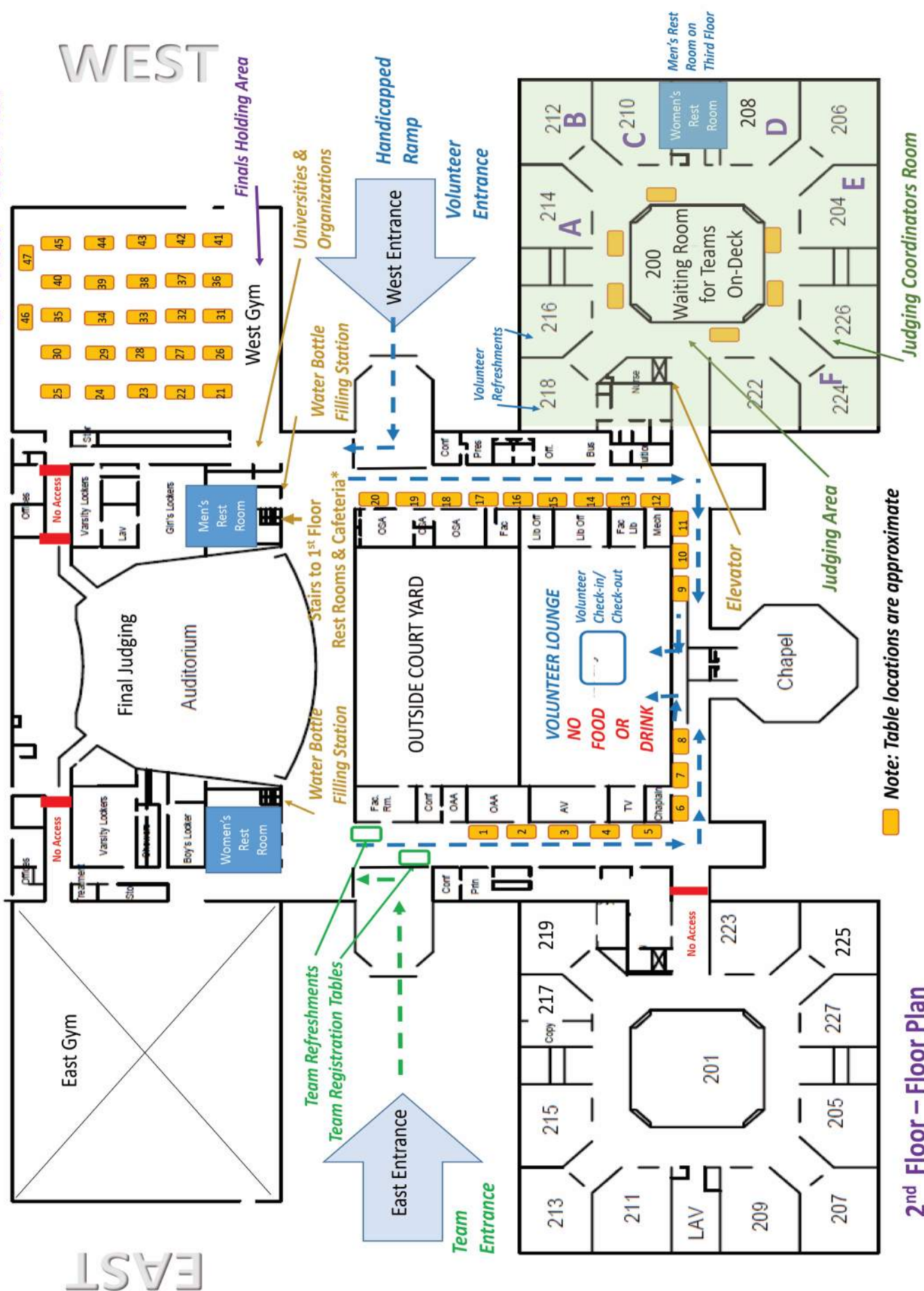




